ERAD2022 information

Dear ERAD2022 participants,

This email provides important information regarding ERAD2022, the participation onsite and online, the presentation of posters and talks. So please take the time to read it entirely.

Program

There were some changes in the program. Please download the latest version from the website.

Poster sessions

- The poster sessions in the program are fully online in Gathertown and can be accessed through the link provided in the e-mail.
- The log-in is regulated via your registered e-mail address. Instructions on how to log in and use Gathertown can be found on the website, where we provide a short guide (<https://www.erad2022.ch/poster>; <https://www.erad2022.ch/guidelinesposters>). The online poster rooms are available from today until the end of the conference.
- We recommend you to test your access to Gathertown as soon as possible to minimize the risk of technical issues.

For participants in Locarno

- Badge pick-up is open on Sunday 28 Aug. from 16:00 until 20:00, and on Monday 29 Aug. from 7:00 until 8:15.
- To access the venue, the coffee and lunch breaks, the icebreaker, the excursion and the social dinner, please always wear your ERAD2022 badge.
- If you have any special dietary requirements, let us please know using the link on the ERAD2022 website until Sunday 28 August at the latest.

Online conference setup

All ERAD participants will receive two Zoom Webinar invitation emails (at the address used for registration) providing the links to the Webinar sessions in Sala 1 and Sala 2. Please note that these links cannot be shared. Installing the Zoom client is not mandatory, you can use your browser by selecting the option “Join from your browser”.

For remote participants

If you attend a session:

- You will be connected as an attendee to one of the two Webinar sessions mentioned above, with access to image and sound from the room in Locarno.
- To ask questions, you will have to use the “Q&A” button in the Webinar window. Questions from this “Q&A” channel will be picked (in a balanced way with questions from participants in Locarno) by the chair of the session and asked to the speaker (and the audience), so no direct answers to all questions in this “Q&A” channel.

If you are presenting during a session:

- You will connect as attendee in the exact same way to the appropriate Webinar session, and your status will then be changed by the session host to panelist so you will be able to share your screen and audio to present your slides and answer questions (see guidelines at <https://www.erad2022.ch/talks>).
- The “Chat” channel is reserved for speakers and hosts to exchange on technical aspects if needed. It becomes accessible when a speaker is changed to panelist.
- We recommend that you connect to Webinar a few minutes before the session officially starts so the status change can be smooth.
- **All remote presenters are asked to send as soon as possible the number of the talk (see program), the first and last names and the registered email address of the presenter to erad2022@meteoswiss.ch.** This is critical information to invite speakers as panelists (so they can share screen and audio).
- You will open your presentation on your own computer, share your screen and change slides by yourself. You must have a proper internet connection and a headset to ensure quality display and audio. Using the microphone of your laptop is strongly discouraged.
- You will have the possibility to test the setup during two test sessions planned on Thu 25 Aug from 16:00 to 17:30 CEST (UTC+2) and on Fri 26 Aug from 09:00 to 10:30 CEST (UTC+2). You will receive the link (specific to those tests) by email, as explained above.
